# **2017 Rules and Regulations for the 2nd Annual Stars & Stripes Independence Day BBQ Showdown Event.**

**BBQ Contenders ONLY.**

**(All money raised for this event goes to benefit our Firework Show)**

The entry fee for food competitors is \$25.00. 1st place winner will receive 50% of the entry fee pot collected. First place is the only winner to receive money. Others will receive prizes.

1. There is no specific meat for this event. Only one type of meat may be used for judging.
2. No ingredient may be pre-cooked in any way prior to the commencement of the official cook off. All other ingredients must be prepared at the event. Meat may be pre-cut or ground. The KRVCC does not prefer one over the other. **MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED.**
3. All contestants can use a BBQ, smoker, or any cooking device of their choice as long as they provide it themselves. **WE DO NOT PROVIDE ELECTRICITY & NO GENERATORS ALLOWED.**
4. You must be at least 18 years old or have an adult accompany you
5. Cook times are 10:00 am-3:00. All food must be off the grill at 3:00pm. Sample prepping is from 2:30-3. All competitors must have their samples ready for judging by 3pm. Judging begins at 3:00 pm, Samples are given out from 3:30pm– 4:00 pm. Winner will be announced at 4:30pm.
6. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils, etc.
7. Each contestant must cook for a minimum of 100 people. These will be served and fit in a 1 oz. size container and **MUST** be served from grill to cup. The KRVCC will provide the 1 oz. containers for you.
8. Public must have a wrist band on to receive a sample (1 sample **ONLY**) This is their vote. **DO NOT GIVE OUT FREE SAMPLES OR YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
9. All competition meats shall be inspected by the KRVCC-APPROVED Meat Inspector prior to serving.
10. Vote for the best BBQ, as defined by the KRVCC, based on favorite tasting sample (Peoples Choice as well as a guest judge). The top 3 contestants will be announced 4:30 pm on the day of the event.

We recommend that BBQs bring a pop up for shade.
